The Trasimeno Cyclepath

- ↔ Length: about 58 km
- 🕒 Cycling time: 4/5 hours

- 🔄 The length indicated on the map was calculated starting from Castiglione del Lago clockwise.
- 🚲 Bicycles can be taken on trains and ferries.

Cyclepath Perugia-Trasimeno

- ↔ Distance: about 29 km
- ⬆️/⬆️ Ascent/Descent: +180m; - 200m.
- 👉 Difficulty: Easy



The Trasimeno Cyclepath The Cyclepath is suitable for mountain, gravel and e-bikes, and ideal for walking. It runs over dirt roads connected to one another by streets. At Borghetto, Passignano sul Trasimeno, Torricella, San Feliciano, Sant'Arcangelo and a short stretch of the via Romea, the route has different characteristics.

Cyclepath Perugia-Trasimeno This route takes you from the beautiful city of Perugia, through its verdant parks and then heads to Lake Trasimeno over paved and dirt roads. Most of the roads have light traffic, except for a difficult stretch leaving Perugia where there is heavy urban traffic. It joins up with the Trasimeno Cyclepath between San Savino and San Feliciano.
