



# Trasimeno for Everyone Accessible Tourism in the Heart of Umbria

The "Trasimeno per Tutti" project was presented at the annual TTG tradeshow in Rimini and is an initiative which aims to transform the Trasimeno area into a truly inclusive destination.

The objective is to make this gorgeous part of Umbria accessible to people of all abilities, in keeping with the principles of the Convention on the Rights of the Physically Challenged. .

The Trasimeno Cycle Route con has been improved with new directional and informational signs, together with specific digital content regarding accessibility via QR codes and NFC indicated on the signs.

Such important cultural landmarks as the Tulle Museum, the Mariottini Collection, the Sbarra Museum and the Glassworks museum also offer new inclusive content in the form of Braille text and tactile reproductions for the vision-impaired, CAA simplified content, audio guides for children, and LIS and IS videos for the hard of hearing.

Trasimeno per Tutti has taken accessibility to new level and is there to make the entire Trasimeno area a destination absolutely everyone can enjoy.







# Castiglione del Lago

"On the border between Umbria and Tuscany stands an enchanting town named Castiglione. Steeped in centuries of history, it protects Trasimeno whilst reflecting its profile in the waters of the lake."

The town's most important building is undoubtedly **Palazzo della Corgna**, which dates to the 16th century (1). Built by the Baglioni family of Perugia, it was initially intended as a hunting lodge but was eventually modified to serve the della Corgna family court. These days it hosts important cultural activities and is home to a fascinating museum that depicts mythological themes and the grandeur and courage of the della Corgna men in frescoes painted by the renowned artist Niccolò Circignani, known as il Pomarancio. A long and ancient covered walkway connects the **Palazzo** to the late 13th century fortress (2), a military fortification built on the remains of an Etruscan acropolis. The keep, which dominates the entire perimeter of Lake Trasimeno and its wonderful landscapes, was added soon after. The ruins of a church dedicated to Saints Philip and James, probably of Byzantine origin, are preserved inside the fortress.





#### WALKS THROUGH HISTORY

Within the walls of the castle is a fascinating amphitheatre which in summer is used for a wide variety of performances and events.

Other landmark buildings are also well worth noting: the church of San Domenico (3) with its museum, and the church of Santa Maria Maddalena (4) home to the famous painting by Eusebio da San Giorgio.

In the outskirts of Castiglione del Lago one can go visit the church of Santa Maria delle Grazie in Casamaggiore and the Santuario della Madonna della Carraia in Panicarola. The former airport of Castiglione del Lago is noteworthy both for the beauty of the nature it preserves and for the fascinating history it is justly proud of.

# Città della Pieve











I his utterly charming medieval town is a favourite for its spectacular landscapes, for its history and amazing art, but also for its delightfully slow pace of life and rich pristine nature.

It is the perfect place to rediscover "the true meaning of Italian lifestyle," and for this reason the residence of choice of many actors, athletes, economists, intellectuals and politicians. The panoramas inspired the greatest painters of the Renaissance and still today attract artists from the world over. It is the birthplace of Raphael's master, Pietro Vannucci, known as "Il Perugino," one of Italy's greatest Renaissance artists in whose paintings the Pieve landscape is a characteristic element. Città della Pieve is home to some of his greatest works: the Adoration of the Magi in the Oratory of Santa Maria dei Bianchi (1), the Baptism of Christ and Our Lady in Glory and Saints in the Cathedral (2) and the Deposition from the Cross in the Diocesan Civic Museum of Santa Maria dei Servi (4), where there is also an exhibition of the Etruscan relics (sarcophagi and urns) that were discovered in the Tomb of San Donnino. Noteworthy contemporary art also makes itself felt in town, with such places as the Lauri Garden (Loc. San Litardo), the Kossut Space (5) and the Photographic Culture Laboratory (Via F. Melosio).









#### **QUADRI VIVENTI - April**

Famous paintings are "enacted" by members of the Terziere Borgo Dentro. Paintings with such traditional themes as the Passion, Death and Resurrection of Christ are brought to life in Palazzo Orca.


# Magione



#### Ancient villages nestled in unforgettable sunsets

The east coast of Lake Trasimeno is dotted with towns and villages steeped in history, graced with beauty: San Savino, with its medieval castle and tower; San Feliciano, an authentic fishing village; Montecolognola, a 14th century hamlet with gorgeous views of the lakeshore; Monte del Lago, an architectural gem perched on high over the lake; Agello with its splendid 11th century fortress; Sant'Arcangelo and Torricella, charming tourist resorts with all the services. Magione, the area's capital, boasts the Castle of the Knights of Malta (1), which was built in the 12th century to serve as a fortified hospital. Beautifully conserved, it can be visited and often hosts guided tastings and cultural events. Magione is also home to the ancient Torre dei **Lambardi (2)**, a tower fortress that was erected at the end of the 12th century by the Knights Hospitaller high on a hill with magnificent views. Magione also boasts a strong vocation for sports, as evidenced by the Autodromo dell'Umbria race track, the sailing and windsurfing along the lake's shoreline, the hiking trails over the hills, the kite flying on the beaches and quad paths in the woods.



# Paciano

Kieran Mulvaney, writer and environmentalist, talks about Paciano in Washington Post: "My first thought when I got here is that this is exactly how a Hollywood set designer would depict a medieval village."

Where to start? From the heart of the old town centre, from the Palazzo Baldeschi information office and TrasiMemo (1), near the Don Aldo Rossi Museum (2). Everywhere you look there is a treasure waiting to be admired: churches, decorations of madonnas, balconies, little mom-and-pop shops selling local food and wine, places which, together with the Town Hall in Piazza della Repubblica, render a lovely harmonious image of a medieval village. The cultural routes include the Church of the Madonna della Stella (3) which boasts some lovely mannerist frescoes. Visiting this area is an opportunity to taste delicious local products and enjoy the landscape that graces the visitor's eyes at every turn. Take, for example, the Via Romea Germanica (a road dating to the 1200s), which from the town of Stade in Germany leads to Rome and, as it passes through Paciano, connects Castiglione del Lago to Città della Pieve.

# **Panicale**









Panicale, on Italy's Loveliest Towns circuit, is perched on a fabulous terrace overlooking Lake Trasimeno and still feels like the medieval castle it once was, with 2 gateways and a characteristic concentric layout. Gettina "lost" in the crisscrossing little streets is always a fascinating way to spend time. Three piazzas on three different levels graced with noteworthy landmarks welcome visitors: the 15th century fountain, the magnificent Collegiata (1), and the Palazzo del Podestà (2). The frescoes in the church of San Sebastiano include the celebrated Martyrdom by II Perugino (1505) and a detached fresco attributed to Raphael and should not be missed, while the Tulle Museum and the della Sbarra are also definitely worth a stop. The Pinacoteca Mariottini, at Palazzo Comunale is home to portraits of illustrious men, and the C. Caporali theatre – an architectural aem and the cultural core of town - hosts plays, concerts, dance performances and operas.







The Beverly Pepper Amphitheatre (9) is a wonderful example of land art and was created by the recently deceased contemporary American artist Beverly Pepper - Mauro Staccioli's Upside-Down Arch - Via Belvedere, (10) sits like an accent mark on the countryside and Virginio Ferrari's Crystals in Formation are seven stone cubes set in front of the entrance to the Madonna della Sbarra museum (7).

#### ART ROUTES AND ACCESSIBILITY

These include: The Sanctuary of the Madonna di Mongiovino (3), a national monument and a pilgrimage site, houses some of the most precious examples of Italian Mannerist painting. The church of San Sebastiano (4) has an access ramp and is equipped with info panels in Italian, English, Braille, LIS and NFC. It houses frescoes by II Perugino and Raphael. The historic Teatro Caporali (5) boasts a beautiful stage curtain painted by Piervittori (1869). The Collegiata di San Michele – the Anita Belleschi Grifoni Tulle Museum is in the Church of Sant'Agostino (6) and is equipped with info panels in Italian, English, Braille, LIS and NFC. Audio descriptions of tactile experiences with the Tulle works made by the master embroiderers of Panicale are available, as are virtual visits and interviews with the embroiderers of Panicale. The Paraments and Sacred Objects museum is in the Church of the Madonna della Sbarra (7) and has touch panels for virtual visits at the entrance. The Mariottini art collection is at the Pinacoteca Comunale (8) and is equipped with info panels in Italian, English, Braille, LIS and NFC.

# Passignano sul Trasimeno



An ancient fishing village nestled between the cool blue waters of the lake and the lush green of the surrounding hills, Passignano is an authentic jewel. The town got its name from being on the road that leads from Tuscany into Umbria over the Passus Jani, or Passo di Giano, the god of thresholds and gateways of ancient Roman mythology. The area surrounding town is great for nature walks and hiking, for horseback riding and cycling. Pieve di San Cristoforo (1), next to the cemetery just outside of town, is Passignano's oldest church and can be dated to the 10th century. The church of the Madonna dell'Oliveto (2) is located in the western part of town and was built towards the end of the 16th century. The Rocca (3), or fortress, probably dates back to Longobardian times (5th to 6th century) and offers breathtaking views over the lake. It hosts exhibitions, concerts, plays and other such cultural events. Perched on a hilltop to the north is the tiny village of Castel Rigone, one of those rare and ideal places that lends itself to cultural and environmental tourism. The Santuario di Maria SS dei Miracoli (4) is an Umbrian Renaissance masterpiece well worth a visit.




# Piegaro

The Piegaro area includes numerous really interesting places, places steeped in history, rich with nature: **the Cibottola Castle**, for example, which still boasts a large section of its ancient walls and a heptagonal tower that is some 20 metres high! Then there are the **Giache and Greppolischieto** castles, both of which have been perfectly restored, or the lovely little village of Castiglion Fosco with its round 16th century tower, or the privately-owned 11th century **Seven Friars Abbey** with its Romanesque church, monastery and courtyard.

Pietrafitta Lake is a paradise for carp fishing, and for fitness buffs. There is **Mt. Arale**, the highest peak in the area at 853m, with its new recreation zone. As you head up towards Piegaro you'll come across the little 16th century church of the **Madonna della Crocetta** before you see the town's old walls and their medieval towers. Worth note, once you're in town, is the **church of San Silvestro Papa**, as well as the lovely palazzo **Misciattelli – Pallavicini**, built in the 18th century and now an historical residence.





#### MUSFUMS

**Museo del Vetro (2)** The museum is inside what was once the focal point of glass-making from the middle ages onwards, and the building itself is an extraordinary example of industrial archaeology. In it you will see the various stages of glassmaking and the structures connected to the work, as well as evolutionary phases over the course of centuries, not to mention the fascinating glass relics left behind by the Piegaro glassmakers themselves

Museo Paleontologico Luigi Boldrini Pietrafitta (1) This unusual museum boasts a collection of fossils dating to the Lower Pleistocene that includes plants, sweet-water molluscs, insects and vertebrae, among which those of mammoths, rhinoceroses, bovines, deer and micro-mammals can be distinguished.

# Tuoro sul Trasimeno



Luoro sits at the northern rim of Lake Trasimeno, on the border with Tuscany. The area's art and ancient history has been organised into four routes. The History-Archaeology Route is focused on the Battle **of Trasimene** and crosses the fields where the epic battle between the Romans and the Carthaginians took place. Made up of 12 rest stops equipped with bi-lingual illustrated informational panels, they explain how the battle was fought. The Museum of Hannibal at Trasimeno (1), a fine example of applied multimedia technology, was recently added to the experience. The nature route leads visitors through verdant woods to the fascinating leaning tower of Vernazzano (2), while Campo del Sole (3) is a lakeside field that is home to 27 sculpted stone columns. The fourth route takes the visitor to **Isola Maggiore**, the largest of the lake's three islands. This route encompasse Franciscan and Renaissance history, including such important landmarks as the beautifully frescoed church of **S. Michele Arcangelo**, the island's Documentation Centre and the Lace Museum (4), home to precious works of lace art made using the so-called Irish Point technique, a heartfelt local tradition. Items include very fine laceworks, wedding dresses and baptism smocks.









#### INFIORATA DEL CORPUS DOMINI - 22 June

Nature and culture intertwine as the Corpus Domini Infiorata comes to life. The streets of the old town centre become an open-air workshop on the night of June 21st, when artists begin to draw a variety of religious designs on the street bed which, at dawn, are "painted in" using coloured flower petals, breathing life into the designs.

# The Park and its Islands

#### Lake Trasimeno Park

The largest park within the Umbrian Regional Park System and because of the valuable plants, animals and fish it hosts, Lake Trasimeno Park is one of Europe's most important and unusual wetlands. The absolute peace and quiet and the pristine landscape make it a truly unique and special place to explore.

#### Aeroporto Eleuteri - Castiglione del Lago

The airport on the shore of Lake Trasimeno was named after a renowned Umbrian aviator, Leopoldo Eleuteri, was once a military airport. Now it is a pristine nature reserve of about 100 hectares and serves as a starting point for hiking, cycling and nature walks. It remains an ENAC certified ultra-light craft air strip and is host to a number of yearly events such as Endurance and the Festival of Kites and Ultra-light Aircraft, as well as being host to the Campus Scolastico Temporaneo Eleuteri of the Polo Scolastico Rosselli Rasetti and the regional LIPU centre, the Equestrian Endurance event and the "Festival del Volo – from kites to ultralight aircraft"

#### Oasi Naturalistica La Valle - San Savino - Magione



The heart of nature in Trasimeno: shallow water and extensive stands of reeds make this an important rest and nesting stop for thousands of birds as they fly along their yearly migratory route. The Oasis has 2 nature paths with 4 observation points, a new 200 metre

wooden walkway over the reeds of an ancient but partly accessible emissary, thirty binoculars visitors can use, a bird-ringing station open every Saturday morning, and a hut with a kitchen and 12 beds. Please visit the website for opening hours and the other services (independent visits, guided tours, nature walks) offered.





#### Isola Maggiore

This island still today looks like the village built by fishermen in the 15th century. Saint Francis came here to spend Lent, and a chapel recalls his arrival and the place on the shore where he prayed. Irish point lace is one of the island's proudest artisanal traditions. The main landmarks to visit are the Lace Museum, the Church of S. Michele Arcangelo and the Casa del Capitano del Popolo.

#### Isola Polvese

The largest of Lake Trasimeno's islands, it is a centre of science and education and has a vast and ecologically important wetland area with reeds that offer a habitat to a variety of bird and amphibian species. Among its historical landmarks are the Church of San Secondo (12th century), the Monastery of the Olivetani monks (15th century), the Church of San Giuliano (11th century) with its Roman Opus Reticolatum, the Defensive Castle (15th century) and the Porcinai pond, named after the architect Pietro Porcingi, which is also called the Garden of Ancient Water Plants. On site accommodations include Villa Biagiotti, now known as the Villa Polvese Resort and Oil Farm", and the Poggio hostel and farm. Visitors can avail themselves of a digital info point, accessible bathroom, an orientation station showing the various trails and offering more information about the island, as well as bilingual audio guides suitable for disabled users.



# The della Corgna family at Trasimeno

The history of the della Corana family began in 1550, when, after Giovanni Maria Ciocchi del Monte was elected Pope (Julius III), his sister Giacoma was aranted the Chiuai Peruaino area to the west of Lake Trasimeno. The first Signore was her son, Ascanio della Corgna, while her brother Fulvio, a cardinal, was appointed Bishop of Peruaia, Ascanio embarked upon a military career fighting under many a banner, and died in 1571 upon his return from the Battle of Lepanto. In 1563 the territory was elevated to the status of Marquisate, with Ascanio and Fulvio the first marguises of Castiglione del Lago: he was succeeded by **Diomede**, son of their sister Laura, adopted by Ascanio, who had no male heirs. Diomede was the one who finished the great buildings his uncles had started - the three Palazzo Coranas in Città della Pieve, Corciano and

Castiglione del Lago, the beautiful villa Colle del Cardingle near Corciano - and then began building his own residential palazzo in Peruaia. When, in 1583, Fulvio died, his summer residences the castle at Pieve del Vescovo and the Seven Friars Abbey in Pietrafitta, which the cardinal had restored and completely frescoed - were abandoned. Diomede's son, Ascanio II, followed him as Marauis, and added a theatre to the palazzo in Castiglione del Lago. His son, Fulvio Alessandro, became the 4th Marauis upon Ascanio's death and he married **Eleonora de Mendoza** from the court of the Viceroy of Naples, and later Teresa Dudley, daughter of the Duke of Northumbria. With the death of Fulvio Alessandro in 1647, the duchy was taken over by the Apostolic Chamber.

#### La via del Trasimeno

A 160 km-long camino in 7 stages around Lake Trasimeno.

A loop camino everyone can do through the area's lovely towns and villages with the great company of the lake and its hills and islands as walking companions. You decide if you want to do all 7 stages in a week, or just do a few of them when you have the time, on a weekend, or as a day trip. Each stretch of the way is about 22 km long, and you can choose where to start and in which direction to walk!




#### La Via Romea Germanica


The German via Romea starts in Stade and ends in Rome and in 2020 was declared a "cultural itinerary" by the Council of Europe. The camino follows the route described

in the 13th century by the Abbot Albert and goes from Germany, through Austria, to Italy. Here, the pilgrimage route goes over the hills that gently slope downwards to the lake and connects to the walking trails and cycling paths in and around Castiglione del Lago, Paciano and Città della Pieve, and then continues on towards Orvieto and Rome



This project aims to promote the roads travelled by both the Divin Pittore (as il Perugino was known) and the Marquises della Corgna over secondary roads in between the towns and villages surrounding the lake in order to fully appreciate the great historical, cultural and environmental heritage they offer. It's a series of itineraries that become a camino!





# Cycle paths of Trasimeno and Perugia - Trasimeno



#### Trasimeno Cycle Path.

#### On-road path

The Cycle Path is an easy one, mostly flat and without any technical difficulties. It can be enjoyed with a mountain, gravel or E bike, on motorised chairs, manual wheelchairs, 4-wheel electrical scooters and hand bikes. The route is entirely sign-posted with tourist plaques and 15 informational boards. The boards have QR codes and an NFC that takes you to the official website, lets you download the GPX traces and get information about the route via both text and audio/visual aids. In the towns of Borghetto, Passignano sul Trasimeno, Torricella, San Feliciano and Sant'Arcangelo, a short stretch of the via Romea, the route continues over roads with different characteristics.

→ Total length: circa 58 km

Total time: 4 to 5 hours

The route length is indicated in a clockwise direction starting from Castialione del Lago

Bikes can be transported on both trains and ferries.

#### Perugia-Trasimeno cycle route

Going through the parks of Perugia, the route heads to Lake Trasimeno on paved roads, with some stretches on dirt roads with little traffic, with the exception of several heavily trafficked roads and some difficult parts, especially leaving the Perugia urban area. Then it joins the Trasimeno Cycle path between San Savino and San Feliciano.

→ Total length: circa 29 km

Ascent and descent: +180m; - 200m.



### Food and Wine

#### CITTÀ DELLA PIEVE SAFFRON

Locally known as croco, over the centuries it has always been a valued bright red treasure that turns orange: we're talking about saffron, a fascinating and ancient spice used above all in cooking. The aim of the Croco di Pietro Perugino Consortium is to raise awareness, protect and promote the production and marketing, and safeguarding it's local typicity and unique characteristics.

#### LAKE TRASIMENO FISH

Fishing has been the livelihood of local families since time immemorial. Today, the professional fishermen of the area work together in cooperatives and, since 2024, their activity has earned them the SLOW FOOD presidia ranking. Queen carp, eel, tench, royal perch, pike and milkfish are all fished here. Queen carp is especially delicious when prepared "in prorchetta." "Tegamaccio," a delicious local version of bouillabaisse, is also worth tasting and is served in a characteristic earthenware bowl.

#### TRASIMENO FAGIOLINA

Cultivated by the Greeks and Etruscans, the Fagiolina thrived throughout the Trasimeno area thanks to the ideal terrain and climate. It is characterised by its small size and its variety of colours. It is a favourite of fine food enthusiasts and great chefs. It earned its Slow Food Presidia rank in 2000, and the consortium that safeguards it, the Fagiolina del Trasimeno Consortium, was formed in 2002.

#### **WINES**

Thanks to the mild climate and ideal soil, the cultivation of wine grapes can be traced back to the Etruscans. Native varieties include Grechetto (a white grape vine), which gives the wine a straw-yellow colour with green tones, and the Gamay del Trasimeno (a black grape vine of the Grenache family) that bless it with a deep granite red hue.

#### **OLIVE OIL**

One of Trasimeno's oldest and most characteristic products is olive oil. The range of varietals includes: Dolce Agogia, Frantoio, Leccino and Moraiolo. The olive groves that dot the lakeshore hillsides provide a fine quality extra virgin oil that bears DOP Umbria and Colli del Trasimeno certification.
